2 Registration Information

3 WAYS TO REGISTER

1. Mail-In Registration

- *Fill out the registration form. (Feel free to copy)
- *Identify class ID CODE as it is noted in the guide.
- *Mail-in registration begins April 15 for residents, non-residents may start mailing in forms April 22. Forms received after these dates will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Forms received prior to April 15 will be returned.
- *You must pay via cash or check when registering by mail.
- *Confirmation receipts will be mailed or emailed to confirm registration.
- *If a program is full, our office will notify you by phone and return your registration.

2. In-Person Registration

- *You are welcome to register in-person at our office located at City Hall, W240 N3065 Pewaukee Rd.
- *In-person registration will start April 15 at 8:00 a.m. for residents, non-residents may start registering April 22.
- *Acceptable forms of payment in-person are cash, check, VISA, MasterCard or Discover.

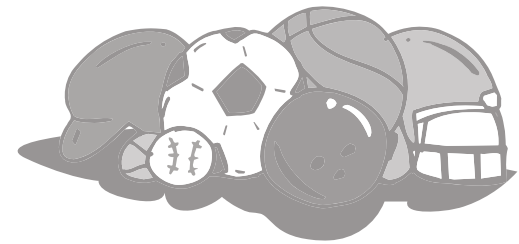

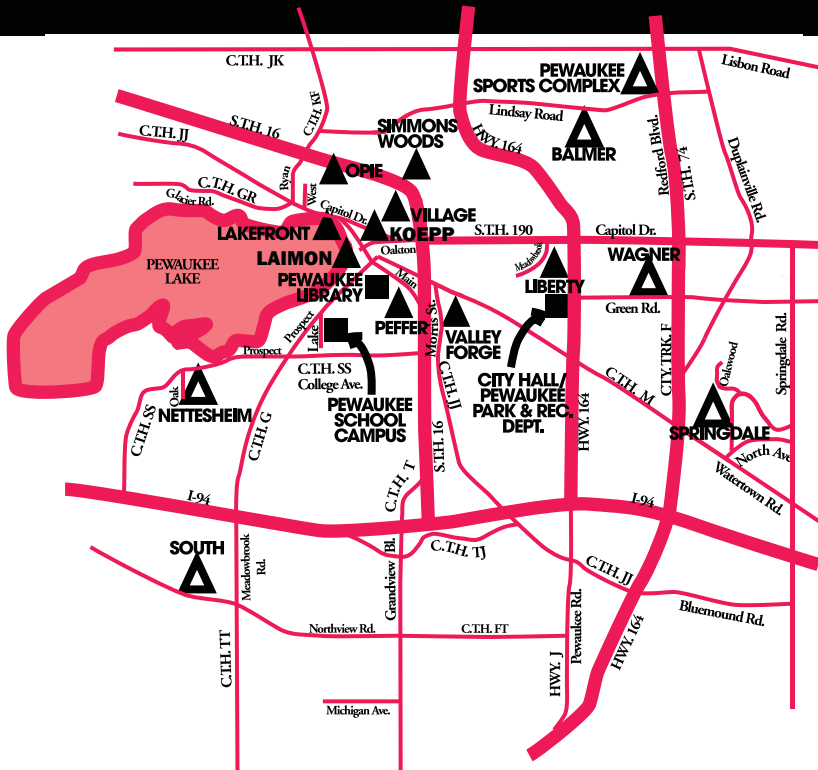
